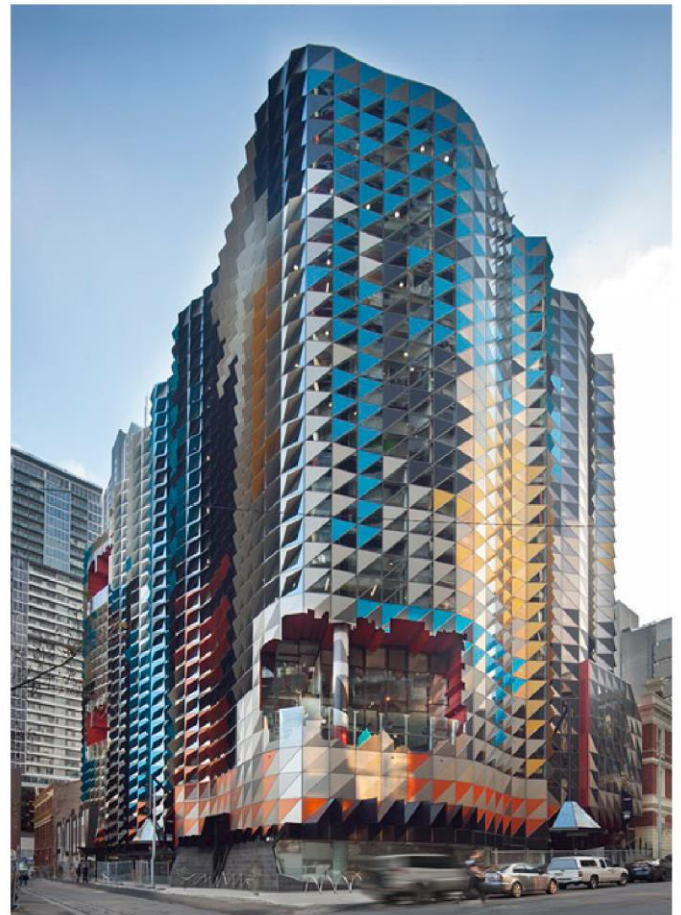


Building 80 (Swanston Academic Building)

Swanston Academic Building (SAB) is one of the newest and most iconic buildings of RMIT University and houses the College of Business. Construction began in 2010 and was completed in 2012. The building incorporates a range of environmentally sustainable features resulting in it achieving a Green Building Council of Australia **5-star Green Star Education Design rating**.



The design approach to the building sought to locate it in dialogue with surrounding architecture, both in form and colour, resulting in a striking facade and interior that is uniquely Melbourne. SAB has received a number of state and national awards including **Best Public Building** in the 2014 Property Council of Australia awards.
