

# RMIT Building 1 (Francis Ormond Building)

**Building 1** as the number suggests is **RMIT's oldest building**. It was built in 2 stages between 1886 and 1892. This is a **landmark building** of great stature and historic significance.



The interior planning of the building has been undertaken on a “**best fit**” basis where each room or space has been closely matched to each function or use. This is an **adaptive re-use** which retains the best of the original building but brings it clearly into the twenty first century.
