

RMIT Building 8

This colourful, awarding-winning building houses our Library and School of Architecture and Design. It's a Swanston Street landmark that has **set the standard for our modern buildings** since the 1990s.

Built in 1993 over the unfinished Union Building, 360 Swanston Street helped put RMIT on the map as a university of modern architecture and design. It's an eclectic mix of brightly coloured stone and mosaics with protruding gold-framed windows whose shapes reference the gothic style of our older city campus buildings.
