



Parliament of Victoria

Parliament House, Melbourne was constructed between 1855 and 1929 and is located on Spring Street in East Melbourne, Victoria. It has served as both the seat of the Parliament of Victoria and as the seat of the Federal Parliament of Australia. The building is listed on the Victorian Heritage Register and celebrated its 150th anniversary in 2005.

Parliament House is open to the public throughout the year.

On non-sitting days the building is open from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm Monday to Friday (closed on public holidays). During sitting days the building opens at 8:30 am and remains open while parliament is sitting. The building is not open on weekends (except for special events such as Open Day).
